Events & Cultural Entertainment, Venues:		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 500 people or see square footage guidelines per venue • A 10-foot distance must be maintained between individual household groups at all times while seated; this may be decreased incrementally based on data & milestone trends • Set an established window time for high-risk groups to come in without pressure from crowds and/or separate entrances and queues • Limit the number of people in a confined area to enable adequate distancing at all times • Maintain signage to remind and help individuals stand at least 6 feet apart when in common areas or while visiting exhibits or events (e.g. Amphitheaters, pavilions, museums, gardens, parks, Farmers Market, beer gardens) • Congregating at any point is not allowed • Encourage contactless payment; disinfect between transactions at facility stores/gift shops and comply with other retail recommendations 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 250 people or see square footage guidelines per venue • A 10-foot distance must be maintained between individual household groups at all times while seated • Mandatory masks by participants and staff • Increase hand washing stations established throughout the venue • High-risk individuals encouraged to stay at home. A virtual component may be added for individuals safer at home to enjoy the programming • Limit the number of people in a confined area to enable adequate distancing at all times • Maintain signage to remind and help individuals stand at least 6 feet apart when in common areas or while visiting exhibits (e.g. Amphitheaters, pavilions, museums, gardens, parks, Farmers Market, beer gardens) • Congregating at any point is not allowed • Encourage contactless payment; disinfect between transactions at facility stores/gift shops and comply with other retail recommendations 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Congregating at any point is not allowed • Spectators encouraged to attend remotely • Encourage contactless payment; disinfect between transactions and comply with other retail recommendations

Family Gatherings (e.g. funeral, wedding, religious ceremonies)	Interactions allowable in larger groups, with strict hygiene measures and symptom monitoring	Based group sizes that enable all social distancing guidelines to be followed	Small group of close family and friends may attend, as long as they have been following social distancing and hygiene practices for two weeks	Only members of the same household or residence may attend
General Guidelines to Consider:				
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Square Footage Guidelines – a standard is needed – one is proposed below. • Mandatory of participants and staff to wear masks. • Increase hand washing stations throughout event grounds – number determined by public health officials • Increased sanitization frequency with every 1-2 hour mandatory “cleaning protocol”. • Plexi-glass or physical barriers in guest services areas • Thorough signage plan in place for gatherings regarding social distancing and guidelines 				

- Ambassadors/Volunteers must not be in an at-risk population
- Limiting capacity with a reservation system: free ticketing and staggered arrival times to events
- Managing lines for social distancing including directing the flow of traffic patterns
- Maximizing seating area distances for general seating and dining
- Managing to-go meals payment and process
- Guest distancing monitors – personnel placed to monitor spacing
- Predefined ingress and egress promoting social distancing throughout event grounds or venue
- Best practices signage for social distancing with visual indicators in all line scenarios
- Digital payments processing prioritized, no cash
- No booths with 10 feet of one another, space booths out throughout festival / event grounds
- At-risk populations are discouraged to attend in person and encouraged to attend virtually *if available

6 Feet Apart	1	36 sq. feet

7 Feet Apart	# of People	Space Required
7 Feet Apart	1	49 sq. feet

8 Feet Apart	# of People	Space Required
8 Feet Apart	1	64 sq. feet
